## **....REMINDER**

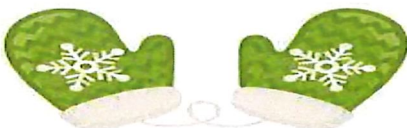
There is no parking on posted

### Plowing/Shoveling Snow/Ice on to Roads

We wish to remind everyone that depositing the snow/ice from your driveway onto a road is not only dangerous, but illegal. WI Statute, "Rules of the Road" 346.94(5) states, "No person shall place or cause to be placed upon a highway any foreign substance which is or may be injurious to any vehicle or part thereof." WI Statute 346.95(3), "Any person violating S.346.95(5) or S.346.95(3) shall be required to forfeit \$100 for each offense

## IMPORTANT!

### Shovel Your Sidewalk

Village ordinance requires that sidewalks be shoveled within 24 hours after a snowfall ends. If your sidewalk has not been shoveled in that time frame,

Village personnel may, without notice, remove the snow/ice. A subsequent charge of \$55.00/hour, minimum 1 hour, then levied upon the property owner abutting the sidewalk.
